Additional Staffing-Ed announced the potential for an Administrative Assistant for the Board.

Amended Eligible Expenses- Ed presented an updated Eligible Expenses list for the Board's Approval. A motion was made by Brad Meixell and seconded by Terri Brooks and the vote passed (10-0) by roll call, a copy of which is attached as Exhibit "B".
